FROM OUR SUMMER SEMINARIAN

Hello! My name is Joseph Szablewski, a seminarian
for the Diocese of Columbus, and I will be spending
most of my summer break with you and Fr. Buffer. I'm
fairly familiar with the Marion area - my mother grew
up in Prospect and my father grew up in Tiffin. I grew
up and currently live (when I'm home from seminary)
in Circleville, about 40 minutes south of downtown
Columbus. I began attending Catholic schools in
Lancaster when I was in the 2nd grade. I entered
seminary at the Pontifical College Josephinum in
Columbus right after graduating high school in 2011.
Although I took a semester away from seminary my
sophomore year to study aerospace engineering, I am
on track to receive my bachelor degree in philosophy
from the Josephinum a year from now. I will then move
on to studies in theology, which take an additional four
years.

I am looking forward to being with you and learning
much from you this summer! In addition to my time at
the parish, I will be in southern Florida from June 15-
July 3 for an immersion into the Spanish language and
culture, so throughout the summer I will be working
on improving my Spanish (which I have not yet learned
to speak). I am sure you will see me around the parish
helping Father with various things - please introduce
yourself (and if you speak Spanish, feel free to help
teach me!). I hope to get to know as many of you as I can
- I only ask your patience as I learn all of your names,
and in return I will be patient with you in learning how
to pronounce my last name! (You can just call me "Joe.")

Please pray for me and for all seminarians this
summer, and know that you are constantly in my
prayers as well.

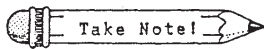

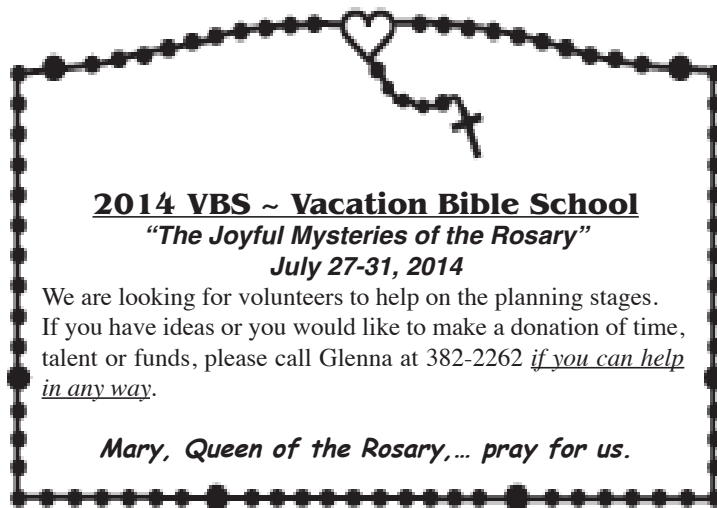
Family Adoration Hour
