On Sunday, June 18, a short Eucharistic procession will begin immediately after 11:00 a.m. Mass. The procession will close with Benediction, celebrated on the front steps of the church. **All parish groups are invited to walk in the procession as a group, carrying a banner or poster.** Show your deep love and respect for Jesus' Real Presence in the Eucharist. Come join us as we sing and praise our Lord and celebrate His great gift to us.

From the Pastor:

Today the Church celebrates Trinity Sunday. The knowledge that God is a communion of Persons helps us understand how we should live as families, communities, and parishes. If God is an eternal communion of love, our own behavior should reflect that great mystery. In the words of Pope Francis, "The feast of the Holy Trinity invites us to engage in daily events to be the leaven of communion, of consolation and of mercy."

On Saturday, June 3, The Most Reverend David Choby, Bishop of Nashville, passed away at age 70. Years ago, when teaching at the Pontifical College Josephinum in Columbus, Bishop Choby assisted with Masses, Confessions, and Baptisms at our parish. Please pray for the repose of his soul and for the Diocese of Nashville as it awaits a new shepherd.

Thanks to some generous support from families in our parish, we have been able to send three more stained glass windows out for restoration. This happened because some families approached us asking whether they could help in this way. All costs of the restoration are being covered by these donations. The three windows in question are The Annunciation (next to the tabernacle), The Immaculate Heart of Mary (high up on the rear wall of the church on the left as you look toward the altar) and The Sacred Heart of Jesus (high on the rear wall, right side). All three of these windows showed a lot of deterioration and some had even been repaired, rather poorly, in the past. We look forward to having them back in splendid and brilliant condition before Christmas.

Del Párroco:

Hoy la Iglesia celebra el Domingo de la Trinidad. El conocimiento que Dios es una comunión de Personas nos ayuda a entender cómo deberíamos vivir como familia, comunidades, y parroquias. Si es que Dios es una comunión de amor, nuestro propio comportamiento debe reflejar ese gran misterio. De las palabras del Papa Francisco, "La celebración de la Santísima Trinidad nos invita para participar en eventos diarios para ser la levadura de comunión, de consolación y de misericordia."

El Sábado, 3 de Junio, El Gran Reverendo David Choby, Obispo de Nashville, murió a la edad de 70 años. Años atrás, cuando enseñaba en el Colegio Pontificio Josefino en Columbus, el Obispo Choby ayudaba con Misas, confesiones, y bautizo en nuestra parroquia. Por favor recen por el descanso de su alma y por la Diócesis de Nashville mientras espera a un nuevo pastor.

Gracias a un apoyo generoso de familias en nuestra parroquia, hemos podido enviar tres ventanas para su restauración. Esto sucede porque algunas familias se acercan a preguntar cómo podrían ayudar en este sentido. Todos los costos de la restauración están cubiertos por estas donaciones. Las tres ventanas mencionadas son La Asuncion (al costado del tabernáculo), El Corazón Inmaculado de María (en la pared alta posterior de la iglesia al lado izquierdo cuando mira al frente del altar) y El Sagrado Corazón de Jesús (en lo alto de la pared posterior, lado derecho). Todas estas tres ventanas muestran una gran deterioración y algunas ya han sido reparadas, algo mal, en el pasado. Esperamos ansiosos a tenerlas de regreso en una condición espléndida y brillante antes de Navidad.
