BAUTISMOS

Los padres de familia tienen que estar registrados en la parroquia y deben asistir fielmente a la Misa; Los padrinos deben de ser Católicos bautizados que hayan recibido el Sacramento de la Primera Comunión y Confirmación, que estén viviendo una vida honesta, y ser mayores de 16 años. Cada niño necesita por lo menos un padrino o madrina. Si tiene dos padrinos, tiene que ser un hombre y una mujer. Si están casados, deben estar casados por la Iglesia Católica, asistir regularmente a la Santa Misa del Domingo, y que estén viviendo su fe. Los padrinos no necesitan ser pareja. Si los padrinos son solteros, deben estar viviendo una vida honesta y casta (continencia, pureza). Las personas que viven con una pareja fuera del matrimonio no son elegibles para ser padrinos.

MATRIMONIO

La Pareja debe tener una reunión con el sacerdote por lo menos seis meses antes de programar la boda. Por lo menos una persona debe estar registrada y estar practicando su fe.

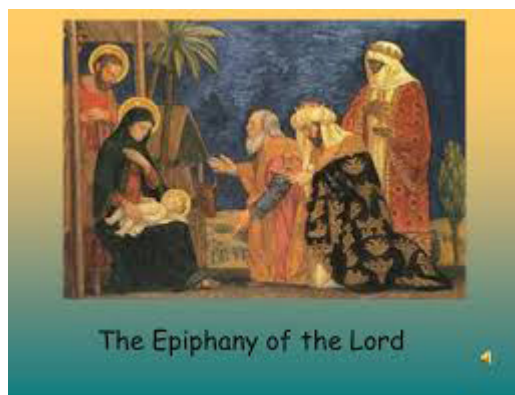

THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD
Sunday, January 7, 2024

PASTOR'S NOTES

Greetings in the Lord, Jesus Christ! This weekend, we celebrate Epiphany which is about the manifestation of Jesus as Lord. The Gospel reading is the visit of the Magi (aka the Three Kings) to the newborn Jesus and how their visit is a recognition of Him as The King of kings. The very next day on Monday, January 8th, we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord which completes the Christmas season.

The day after that, we begin Ordinary Time, wearing green vestments at Mass. Ordinary Time means that the liturgical weeks are counted (ordinals), such as the "1st week in Ordinary Time." During the 33 or 34 weeks of Ordinary Time throughout the year, the fullness of the mystery of Christ is celebrated until we get to those distinctive seasons that celebrate certain mysteries of Christ, such as Lent, Easter, Advent, and Christmas. The first weeks of Ordinary Time will last just over a month before we arrive at Ash Wednesday, February 14th, which begins the Lenten season. Ordinary Time will then resume after Easter.

As stated in the St. Andrew Bible Missal, 1982, "Ordinary Time is not very ordinary at all. Ordinary Time, the celebration of Sunday, is the identifying mark of the Christian community which comes together, remembering that on this first day of the week, the Lord of Life was raised up and creation came at last to completion. Sunday as a day of play and worship is a sacrament of redeemed time. How we live Sunday proclaims to the world what we believe about redeemed time now and for ever. What happens in our churches every Sunday is the fruit of our week. What happens as the fruit of the week past is the beginning of the week to come. Sunday, like all sacraments, is simultaneously a point of arrival and departure for Christians on their way to the fullness of the kingdom. This is not ordinary at all. This is the fabric of Christian living."

May life never be "ordinary" for you, but rather a joy on the journey towards the fullness of Christ's kingdom!

PASTOR'S NOTES

¡Saludos en el Señor Jesucristo! Este fin de semana celebramos la Epifanía, que se trata de la manifestación de Jesús como Señor. La lectura del Evangelio es la visita de los Reyes Magos (también conocidos como los 3 Reyes) al Jesús recién nacido y cómo su visita es un reconocimiento de él como El Rey de reyes.

Al día siguiente, lunes 8 de enero, celebramos el Bautismo del Señor que completa la temporada navideña. Al día siguiente, comenzamos el Tiempo Ordinario, vistiendo vestimentas verdes en la Misa. Tiempo Ordinario significa que se cuentan las semanas litúrgicas (ordinales), como la "primera semana del Tiempo Ordinario". Durante las 33 o 34 semanas del Tiempo Ordinario a lo largo del año, se celebra la plenitud del misterio de Cristo hasta llegar a esas estaciones distintivas que celebran ciertos misterios de Cristo, como la Cuaresma, la Pascua, el Adviento y la Navidad. Las primeras semanas del Tiempo Ordinario durarán poco más de un mes antes de llegar al Miércoles de Ceniza, el 14 de febrero, que comienza la temporada de Cuaresma. El Tiempo Ordinario se reanudará después de Pascua.

Como se afirma en el Misal Bíblico de San Andrés, 1982, "El Tiempo Ordinario no es nada ordinario. El Tiempo Ordinario, la celebración del domingo, es la seña de identidad de la comunidad cristiana que se reúne recordando que en este primer día de la semana resucitó el Señor de la Vida y la creación llegó por fin a su cumplimiento. El domingo como día de juego y adoración es un sacramento del tiempo redimido. La forma en que vivimos el domingo proclama al mundo lo que creemos sobre el tiempo redimido ahora y por siempre. Lo que sucede en nuestras iglesias cada domingo es el fruto de nuestra semana. Lo que sucede como fruto de la semana pasada es el comienzo de la semana venidera. El domingo, como todos los sacramentos, es al mismo tiempo un punto de llegada y de salida para los cristianos en su camino hacia la plenitud del reino. Esto no es nada normal. Éste es el tejido de la vida cristiana".

¡Que la vida nunca sea "ordinaria" para ti, sino más bien una alegría en el camino hacia la plenitud del reino de Cristo!

THE SATURDAY MORNING MEN'S GROUP

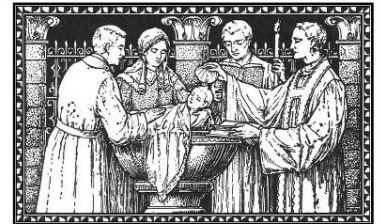

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING OF THE SICK

Are you planning for a scheduled medical procedure, or are you being admitted to a hospital or other outpatient facility for surgery or for medical treatment? If so, please see one of the priests before or after any of our parish Masses so that he can provide you with the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick **BEFORE** you have your procedure, treatment or surgery. In the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, the priest anoints the seriously ill, injured, or the elderly with the "Oil of the Infirm" which is a special oil, blessed by the Bishop, used for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. Obviously, there are emergency situations, but anything that you can do in advance to receive the sacramental graces of the Anointing of the Sick – physical, spiritual and emotional healing – is helpful to you, your family, and to the priests.
