**BAUTISMOS** - Los padres de familia tienen que estar registrados en la parroquia y deben asistir fielmente a la Misa; Los padrinos deben de ser Católicos bautizados que hayan recibido el Sacramento de la Primera Comunión y Confirmación, que estén viviendo una vida honesta, y ser mayores de 16 años.

Cada niño necesita por lo menos un padrino o madrina. Si tiene dos padrinos, tiene que ser un hombre y una mujer. Si están casados, deben estar casados por la Iglesia Católica, asistir regularmente a la Santa Misa del Domingo, y que estén viviendo su fe. Los padrinos no necesitan ser pareja. Si los padrinos son solteros, deben estar viviendo una vida honesta y casta (continencia, pureza). Las personas que viven con una pareja fuera del matrimonio no son elegibles para ser padrinos.

**MATRIMONIO** - La Pareja debe tener una reunión con al sacerdote por lo menos seis meses antes de programar la boda. Por lo menos una persona debe estar registrada y estar practicando su fe.

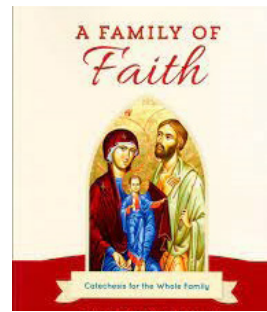

#### SPIRIT OF PEACE CLINICAL COUNSELING

I came across an article on the tactics of the devil and was reminded of how he uses the same tactics we see played out in daily life: deception, division, diversion, and discouragement. We may initially be thinking of this in the spiritual sense, but the devil's tactics are also used in addiction, anxiety, being unable to heal trauma wounds, and almost every facet of disordered thinking related to mental health. His tactics are sneaky, so consider counseling to help distinguish between lies and the truth or read the book by Fr. Louis Cameli, *The Devil You Don't Know*.

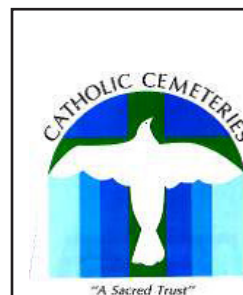

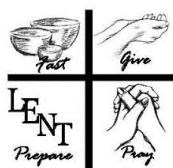

**SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING OF THE SICK:** Are you planning for a scheduled medical procedure, or are you being admitted to a hospital or other outpatient facility for surgery or for medical treatment? If so, please see one of the priests before or after any of our parish Masses so that he can provide you with the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick **BEFORE** you have your procedure, treatment or surgery. In the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, the priest anoints the seriously ill, injured, or the elderly with the "Oil of the Infirm" which is a special oil, blessed by the Bishop, used for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. Obviously, there are emergency situations, but anything that you can do in advance to receive the sacramental graces of the Anointing of the Sick – physical, spiritual and emotional healing – is helpful to you, your family, and to the priests. Thank you!


