BAUTISMOS - Los padres de familia tienen que estar registrados en la parroquia y deben asistir fielmente a la Misa; Los padrinos deben de ser Católicos bautizados que hayan recibido el Sacramento de la Primera Comunión y Confirmación, que estén viviendo una vida honesta, y ser mayores de 16 años.

Cada niño necesita por lo menos un padrino o madrina. Si tiene dos padrinos, tiene que ser un hombre y una mujer. Si están casados, deben estar casados por la Iglesia Católica, asistir regularmente a la Santa Misa del Domingo, y que estén viviendo su fe. Los padrinos no necesitan ser pareja. Si los padrinos son solteros, deben estar viviendo una vida honesta y casta (continencia, pureza). Las personas que viven con una pareja fuera del matrimonio no son elegibles para ser padrinos.

MATRIMONIO - La Pareja debe tener una reunión con al sacerdote por lo menos seis meses antes de programar la boda. Por lo menos una persona debe estar registrada y estar practicando su fe.

**PASTOR'S NOTES**

Greetings in the Lord, Jesus Christ! In the bulletin, we have been advertising that those who are going in for a major surgery should request the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. Recently, Bishop Fernandes has reminded all priests of the proper application of this Sacrament stating that "Canon Law and the Ritual stipulate that the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is for those who, having reached the age of reason, are in danger of death, whether as a result of illness or old age (c. 1004). Those who do not meet these criteria, such as infants, young children prior to the age of reason, and those who lack a serious illness that places them in danger of death, are not to receive the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. This includes even those who, though undergoing elective surgery, are not seriously ill. The administration of anesthesia does not constitute a grave illness." In other words, a sick person may be anointed before surgery whenever a serious illness is the reason for the surgery. If the surgery is not due to a serious illness, the proper Sacraments to receive are Reconciliation and the Eucharist. To be anointed, a person does not have to be on their deathbed, but their illness must be serious enough that it places them in danger of death or at the beginning of the danger of death. Please do call the priests, though, for the Sacrament if someone is seriously ill or if it is questionable.

A reminder that we do have our Day of Adoration this Friday, March 15th from after the 8:30 a.m. Mass until 6:00 p.m. Please come and spend a Holy Hour with the Lord.

¡Saludos en el Señor Jesucristo! En el boletín hemos estado anunciando que quienes van a someterse a una cirugía mayor deben solicitar el Sacramento de la Unción de los Enfermos. Recientemente, el Obispo Fernandes ha recordado a todos los sacerdotes la correcta aplicación de este Sacramento afirmando que "el Derecho Canónico y el Ritual estipulan que el Sacramento de la Unción de los Enfermos es para aquellos que, habiendo alcanzado el uso de razón, se encuentran en peligro de muerte, ya sea por enfermedad o por vejez (c. 1004). Aquellos que no cumplan con estos criterios, como los bebés, los niños pequeños antes del uso de razón y aquellos que carezcan de una enfermedad grave que los ponga en peligro de muerte, no deben recibir el Sacramento de la Unción de los Enfermos. Esto incluye incluso a aquellos que, aunque se someten a una cirugía electiva, no están gravemente enfermos. La administración de anestesia no constituye una enfermedad grave". En otras palabras, una persona enferma puede ser ungida antes de la cirugía siempre que el motivo de la cirugía sea una enfermedad grave. Si la cirugía no se debe a una enfermedad grave, los Sacramentos adecuados a recibir son la Reconciliación y la Eucaristía. Para ser ungido, una persona no tiene que estar en su lecho de muerte, pero su enfermedad debe ser lo suficientemente grave como para ponerla en peligro de muerte o al comienzo del peligro de muerte. Sin embargo, llame a los sacerdotes para recibir el Sacramento si alguien está gravemente enfermo o si tiene dudas.

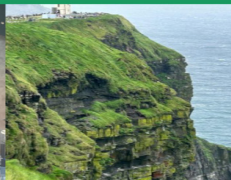

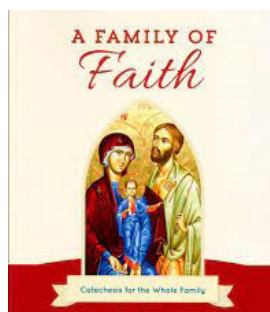

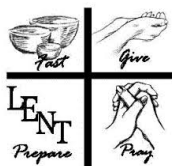
