### A NEWS FLASH FROM ST. VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY

A note to let you know how all your donations and volunteer hours help in giving aid to our less fortunate people in Marion. The pantry served 2,494 clients in the first three months. Some items that could be used in the pantry and not always available from Mid- Ohio Food Bank include jelly, soups, Tuna Helper and Ramon noodles. Items can be delivered at the Center during business hours or placed in the basket in the vestibule.

The No Waste Program has been a big success. In conjunction with Kroger and Meijer, we pickup produce, dairy, bakery goods, meat and dry food items twice a week. Volunteers are needed to help in this effort. Please contact Michael Bowe at 740-341-3380 to help continue this project.

#### **PLENARY INDULGENCES**

The Dominican Order is currently celebrating a Triple Jubilee in honor of St. Thomas Aquinas, remembering the 700th anniversary of his canonization (which was celebrated in July 2023), the 750th anniversary of his death (celebrated on March 7, 2024), and the 800th anniversary of his birth (which will be celebrated in 2025). In honor of these anniversaries, the Apostolic Penitentiary grants a plenary indulgence to those who make a pilgrimage to a holy place connected with the Dominican Order, and there devoutly take part in the jubilee ceremonies, or at least devote a suitable time to pious recollection, concluding with the Lord's Prayer, the Creed, and invocations of the Blessed Virgin Mary and of Saint Thomas Aquinas. Any church, shrine, or chapel currently entrusted to the Dominican Order can meet the requirements for the pilgrimage. In the Diocese of Columbus, St. Patrick Church in Columbus, St. Joseph Church in Somerset, and Holy Trinity Church in Somerset are entrusted to the Dominican Friars. The plenary indulgence may be obtained until January 28, 2025 under the usual conditions of Sacramental Confession 20 days before or after the indulgenced act, reception of Holy Communion, prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father, and complete detachment from sin, including venial sin. 
