Testimony:

I always believed Jesus was real, but I never felt as if He has shown Himself to me until February of 2023. I had just received a heart transplant and was sedated for 5 days after the procedure. During the 5 days of being sedated and on ECHO, I remember being in a very dark place. All I could see were mountains of dark rocks. The air was really heavy and it made it hard to breathe. I remember feeling like I was stuck. All around me I could hear loud clinks of chains hitting the ground, but I couldn't see anyone. Then all of a sudden, I remember being woken up by four of my doctors who seemed stressed about the operation, but they were also relieved I was awake. The doctors spent the 10-15 minutes in my room, asking me various questions and making sure I didn't have any brain damage. Once they were pleased with my responsiveness, they left the room. After the doctors were gone, I looked to the left of my bed and saw Jesus standing by the dry erase board, looking back at me. Jesus appeared to be very tired, dirty and His garb was ripped and torn. As Jesus looked at me, He did not show any emotional expressions or say anything to me. He then walked past my bed and went to the back of my hospital room and I never saw Him again. It was then that I knew He had saved me.

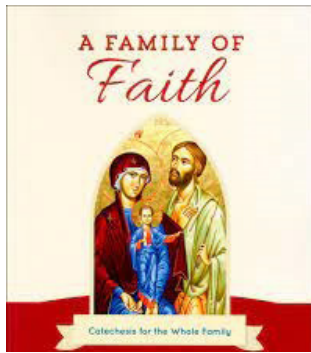

call the parish office. We are trying to get a group together for adult confirmations in the coming months. More details will be forthcoming from the priests after we determine who is in need of Confirmation.



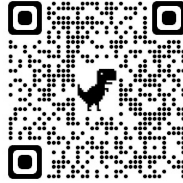

PLENARY INDULGENCES

The Dominican Order is currently celebrating a Triple Jubilee in honor of St. Thomas Aquinas, remembering the 700th anniversary of his canonization (which was celebrated in July 2023), the 750th anniversary of his death (to be celebrated on March 7, 2024), and the 800th anniversary of his birth (which will be celebrated in 2025). In honor of these anniversaries, the Apostolic Penitentiary grants a plenary indulgence to those who make a pilgrimage to a holy place connected with the Dominican Order, and there devoutly take part in the Jubilee ceremonies, or at least devote a suitable time to pious recollection, concluding with the Lord's Prayer, the Creed, and invocations of the Blessed Virgin Mary and of Saint Thomas Aquinas. Any church, shrine, or chapel currently entrusted to the Dominican Order can meet the requirements for the pilgrimage. In the Diocese of Columbus, St. Patrick Church in Columbus, St. Joseph Church in Somerset, and Holy Trinity Church in Somerset are entrusted to the Dominican Friars. **The plenary indulgence may be obtained until January 28, 2025** under the usual conditions of Sacramental Confession 20 days before or after the indulgenced act, reception of Holy Communion, prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father, and complete detachment from sin, including venial sin. DOUBTS

Reflection on John 20:19-31

With the Apostle Thomas, there is both vulnerability and capability, both suspicion and consent, both doubt and faith. He is at first suspicious of the report of the Risen Jesus, wishing to not get "caught up" in what might be fake news. But when confronted in person with the presence of the Risen Lord, he does not push that suspicion to the edge of the ridiculous, but affirms the truth of what he has now arrived at.

It is not a sign of weakness to question one's faith. On the contrary, accepting doubt as a natural part of what it means to be human, one's questioning is a sign of an engaging and curious mind and heart. Through this journey of doubting and questioning, we move ever deeper into our relationship with God. Doubts and questions are an opportunity for spiritual growth.

This is spiritual integration. Rather than judge one side as unworthy of being a disciple (the experiences of doubt we all have), and accept faith as the absence of all questioning (which it clearly is not), Thomas represents the real and authentic journey we all make as we move ever more deeply into the recognition that God, in the Risen Christ, is present in every human experience, and that, as Richard Rohr says, "Everything belongs!"

SAINT STANISLAUS

Saint of the Day: April 11

Patron Saint of: Poland

Anyone who reads the history of Eastern Europe cannot help but chance on the name of Stanislaus, the saintly but tragic bishop of Kraków, patron of Poland. He is remembered with Saints Thomas More and Thomas Becket for vigorous opposition to the evils of an unjust government.

Born in Szczepanow near Kraków on July 26, 1030, he was ordained a priest after being educated in the cathedral schools of Gniezno, then capital of Poland, and at Paris. He was appointed preacher and archdeacon to the bishop of Kraków, where his eloquence and example brought about real conversion in many of his penitents, both clergy and laity. He became bishop of Kraków in 1072.

During an expedition against the Grand Duchy of Kiev, Stanislaus became involved in the political situation of Poland. Known for his outspokenness, he aimed his attacks at the evils of the peasantry and the king, especially the unjust wars and immoral acts of King Boleslaus II.

The king first excused himself, then made a show of penance, then relapsed into his old ways. Stanislaus continued his open opposition in spite of charges of treason and threats of death, finally excommunicating the king. Enraged, the latter ordered soldiers to kill the bishop. When they refused, the king killed Stanislaus with his own hands. Forced to flee to Hungary, Boleslaus supposedly spent the rest of his life as a penitent in the Benedictine abbey in Osiak.

Saints John the Baptist, Thomas Becket, Thomas More, and Stanislaus are a few of the prophets who dared to denounce corruption in high places. They followed in the footsteps of Jesus Himself, who pointed out the moral corruption in the religious leadership of His day. It is a risky business.
